Museums and galleries

1 Krustpils castle and Jēkabpils History museum , Rīgas Street 216B, www.jekabpilsmuzejs.lv, 27008136	Mentioned in chronicles for the first time in 1237. For several centuries the castle belonged to the Korff family. After extensive reconstruction of the castle, now you can walk through luxurious halls and spacious corridors, explore new exhibitions about the history of the city. Exhibitions are held in the castle tower and exhibition halls, museum offers themed tours and educational programs. The customer center offers souvenirs and local products, as well as an exposition about the history of tourism in Jekabpils.
2 Selonian Farmstead – open-air division of Jēkabpils History museum Filozofu Street 6, www.jekabpilsmuzejs.lv, 27029039	The exhibition consists of six 19 th century Selonian buildings - dwelling house, grain barn, small barn, forge, windmill and bath house. The architecture and layout of the buildings reflect the ancient craftsmanship and construction skills. Crafts House has an exposition about craft traditions in Selonia and offers various practical classes.
3 Mans's- Art gallery Brīvības Street 154, www.manss.lv, 29470597	One of the first private art galleries in Latvia. The extensive premises of the gallery house paintings by Latvian and foreign artists.

Memorial sites

Object / Address	Description
4 Monument to the victims of repressions , Rīgas Street, by the Krustpils Lutheran Church	A monument dedicated to the victims of the Soviet repressions. Unveiled on 25 March 1989.
5 The Monument “For those who have fallen for the motherland” , Rīgas Street, opposite the Krustpils Castle	Dedicated to the memory of soldiers of Krustpils fallen in the Freedom Battles. Designed by A. Birznieks and built from donations. Unveiled in 1925, destroyed during Soviet times, restored in 1992.
6 House of organist Pēteris Sīpolnieks Brīvības Street 141	P. Sīpolnieks was a music teacher and one of the most famous organists in Latvia. His family home was built in 1820.
7 Memorial stone to the deportees of 1941 , Parka Street	15 oaks and 13 lindens were planted on the site where the stone is placed in remembrance of 28 people deported from Krustpils to Siberia.
8 Memorial to the victims of WWI and military cemetery , Zajā Street, on the lawn next to the Jēkabpils State Gymnasium.	Dedicated to more than 300 soldiers of the 3rd Caucasian rifleman regiment of the Russian Army who died fighting against the German forces. 139 soldiers and two officers are buried in the military cemetery.
9 “Little violinist” a sculpture in memory of Jāzeps Vītols , Pasta Street 1	A sculpture has been dedicated to the memory of the outstanding composer J.Vītols – “The Little Violinist” with a commemorative plaque.
10 Commemorative site for Ita Kozakeviča , Rīgas Street	Ita Marija Kozakeviča worked in the Popular Front of Latvia. Member of the Presidium of the Supreme Council of Latvia, chairwoman of the Human Rights Commission, participated in the revival of Latvian Polish Union. Received the honorary title “Woman Latvia”.

Parks and sights

Object / Address	Description
11 Strūve Park Strūves Street	The park became famous due to the point of Struve Geodetic Arc measured by the professor of Tartu University, astronomer and geodesist Wilhelm von Struve. The Struve Geodetic Arc is on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Park is landscaped and has information about the Struve arc.
12 Akmeņu Street Square	Corner of Pasta and Akmeņu streets is called also Nut Square due to the walnut trees that are growing there. Central environmental objects - a fountain with a stone sphere and sculptures by the sculptor Vija Dzintare - “Austras tree” and “Gates”.
13 Former Wednesday market square Brīvības Street 214	On this spot on 12 th February 1670, Duke Jacob declared the foundation of Jekabpils city. It was the oldest market of the town and the former historic centre.

14 Fountain “Dandelion Fluff” Located near the Jēkabpils State Gymnasium	Sculptures by the sculptor L. Blumbergs can be seen next to the fountain.
15 Rest place near Jēkaba Street	Here you can see an environmental object in honor of the founder of the city Duke Jacob.
16 Kens manor and park Dambja Street	A former manor – the only 19 th century neogothic building in Jēkabpils. Now the building houses Jēkabpils Art School. There is also a children playground available and a secular tree of national importance in the park – a European larch.
17 Forest Park, Radži water reservoir and Bird watching tower Mežaparka Street	The park was planted in 1966 to protect the city from the dust created in the dolomite quarry. The Forest Park is located next to Radži water reservoir, which has a Blue Flag beach. On one of islets there can be seen Radži grand stone – with height of 3.1 m and girth of 19.5 m. An active recreation area is available on site.
18 Environmental object - sculpture “Prosperity” Rīgas Street 103B, near Krustpils market	It is located in a place where the Krustpils market is taking place. The sculpture depicts a woman - a mother who has come to the market to take care of her family. There is a coin in her hands, which can increase well-being of those who touch it.

Churches

19 The Orthodox Church of The Holy Spirit and men's monastery Brīvības Street 200, 20451706	The church was built in the second part of the 19th century in Byzantine style. The Saint Nicholas The Miracle-worker's church unique with its small size of only 17 by 19.5 meters is located in the monastery courtyard.
20 Krustpils Lutheran Church Rīgas Street 221A, 29107876, www.krustpilsbaznica.lv	Built in the 17th century, damaged and rebuilt a number of times. In 1999 the church received the blue flag of the European Cultural Heritage.
21 Krustpils Roman Catholic Church of the Holy Trinity Kalna Street 33, 65230322	The church is unique for its location as it is the only church in Jēkabpils that rises so high above a city. It is the first Catholic church on the right bank of Daugava river.
22 Krustpils St. Nicolaus Orthodox Church Zīlānu Street 57, 65223886	Stone church was built in Byzantine style in honour of Saint Nicolaus, consecrated in 1910. After WWII, walls were all that remained from the church.
23 Jēkabpils St. Michael Lutheran Church Brīvības Street 125, 65235455, 29234062	Construction was commenced in 1769 and the church was consecrated on 15th December 1807. It features an artefact of national significance – the double-manual organ built by the renowned master Mārtiņš Krēslīņš in 1885.
24 Jēkabpils Old-Believers Church Viestura Street 15, 65233780, 25914381, www.jekabpils-pomor.lv	Beautiful wooden building is a National Cultural Monument and one of the oldest Old Believers' churches in Latvia, built in 1889, renovated and rebuilt in 1978.
25 Jēkabpils St. Roman Catholic Church of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary Brīvības Street 105, 65233174	The mid-19th century church which was restored in 1933 attracts attention with its 14 m high belfry, the sounds of the 272 kg bell, the benches dating from 1907, the sound of the new organ, the statue of Our Lady of Fatima carried over from Portugal.
26 Jēkabpils Baptist Church Zajā Street 5, 65232535	The Baptist congregation was formed after the great city fire in 1880 when people from remote settlements were called to restore the city. The current church was built in 1930.
27 The Orthodox Church of the Sanctuary of Holy Mother of God (Uniate Church) Brīvības Street 167, 65231486	One of the largest churches in Jēkabpils built in 1783 during the reign of Duchy of Courland. Church is a national historical monument.

Architecture

Object / Address	Description
28 Old Town Square	At the beginning of the 20th century, the current Old Town Square developed as the city's market square. Most of the buildings around the it were built between 19th and 20th centuries. Now guests are greeted by the symbol of the city – lynx. Also various environmental objects are reminding of the former bustle of the market.
29 O. Kalpak's Square	Former festivity parade ground. In 1928 to honor Latvia's tenth birthday it was renamed to Kalpaka Square. Improved with tourism infrastructure of Strūve geodetic arc.
30 Daugava embankment – promenade On both banks of River Daugava	The construction of the embankment was commenced in 1981 after the great floods. In 2011 the embankment was renovated and improved. Now, walking along the pedestrian promenade, you can enjoy beautiful views of the city and the calm flow of the river Daugava.

31 Bridge across Daugava Connecting both banks of River Daugava	The first bridge with a railway line across the Daugava was built in 1936. It was destroyed during WWII. In 1962 the current bridge was built, uniting two cities Krustpils and Jēkabpils under one name - Jēkabpils.
32 The former district school Pasta Street 1	The former district school was built in 1820 in the Classicist style. It adds a majestic touch to the centre of the city with its massive columns. The building currently houses the Jēkabpils College of Agrobusiness.
33 19th century dwelling house ensemble Pasta Street 81-87	Witnesses of the old town planning – the so-called “string houses”. The land plots on which homes were built were several hundred meters long, but only a few meters wide, therefore houses were built with the façade facing the street.
34 19th century dwelling house Pasta Street 77/79	Historic architecture of Jēkabpils – a filled framework building.
35 An ensemble of dwelling houses Brīvības Street 178-184	The houses were built in the 1870s and feature longitudinal construction.
36 The former Jēkabpils district courthouse , Brīvības Street 120	The building was built in the Russian classicism style and intended for the Jēkabpils district court. Now it houses Jēkabpils City Council.
37 The former National Bank building A. Pormaļa Street 11	It was built in 1931 in classicism style. The centre of the facade is decorated by four column-like projections crested with chapters.
38 Tunnel at the bridge across Daugava Plaviņu Street under bridge	The tunnel (43.04 m) is one of the few parabolic monolithic reinforced concrete structures in Latvia, which was built in the 1930s. The underpass still retains the original cobblestone pavement.
39 The stone “Love Bridge” Rīgas Street 21 1a, at the Krustpils Lutheran Church	This single-span dolomite arch bridge built in late 19th century across the Donaviņa river next to the Krustpils Lutheran Church is a monument of industrial heritage.
40 Open-air stage on Krustpils (Adamsons') islet Krustpils islet	The cultural and entertainment events taking place here draw crowds of thousands. A linden stretches its branches proudly – it is among the largest trees in Latvia.

41 Forest Park Mežaparka Street, 22000498, www.jekabpils.lv	Boat hire, fishing and spear fishing in Radži water reservoir, skiing track and hill with lift in winter. Blue flag beach, nature trails, beach volleyball and street ball pitches.
42 All season Tube Sliding Track Jēkabpils Forest Park, 22000498, www.jekabpils.lv	The length of the track is more than 80 m. Inflatable camera and lift rental available.
43 Wakepark , Mežaparka Street 15, 28367165, veikparks.lv	By the Radži water reservoir, right next to the Blue Flag beach. Wake sets and SUP boards from sunrise to sunset, events and relaxation on the terrace of the wakepark.
44 Go-kart hall in Jēkabpils Ausekļa Street 3, 20579691, 22356249	Go-kart rides on indoor track. Rental of premises for events.
45 X3M paintball club Zīriņu Street 5, 29231394, www.x3m.lv	Paint-balling in an equipped field for large and small groups, equipment.
46 “K Rent” quad bike rental Kļavas, Ābeļu Parish, 22485883, 27015550	Offers to rent quad bikes for active recreation in Jēkabpils
47 Jēkabpils Sports Hall Brīvības Street 289, 22000498, www.jekabpils.lv	Ice rink, sports hall with fields for team games, gym and outdoor court.
48 Pump track Filozofu Street 15	Adapted for riders of all ages and levels. Specially designed asphalt track with slopes, bends and small springboards.
49 Mini-golf Zemgales Street 9b, 27720500, 20029197	Mini-golf invites you with bright playing fields and exciting moments in the neon world!
