

# JĒKABPILS

The Baptist church was formed after the great city fire in 1880 when people from remote settlements were called to restore the city. The current church was built in 1930.

**13 The Orthodox Church of the Sanctuary of Holy Mother of God (Uniate Church)**  
One of the largest churches in Jēkabpils built in 1783 during the reign of Duchy of Courland. Church is a national historical monument.

**14 The Monument "For those who have fallen for the motherland"**  
Dedicated to the memory of soldiers of Krustpils fallen in the Freedom Battles. Designed by A. Birznieks and built from donations. Unveiled in 1925, destroyed during Soviet times, restored in 1992.

**15 Monument to the victims of repressions**  
A monument dedicated to the victims of Soviet repressions. Unveiled on 25 March 1989.

**16 Memorial stone to R. Pārups national partisan group**  
Rihards Pārups (1914–1946) was born in Krustpils parish. During World War II was a sergeant in the anti-tank division of the 15th Latvian Division. Participated in national partisan operations, was a member of the National Resistance Movement, head of the unit in the vicinity of Jēkabpils and Madona. The memorial stone was created by the sculptor Ilgvars Mozulāns.

**17 Memorial stone to the deportees of 1941**  
15 oaks and 13 lindens were planted on the site where the stone is placed in remembrance of 28 people deported from Krustpils to Siberia.

**18 Memorial to the victims of WWI and military cemetery**  
Dedicated to more than 300 soldiers of the 3rd Caucasian rifle regiment of Russia Army who died fighting against the German forces. 139 soldiers and two officers are buried in the military cemetery.

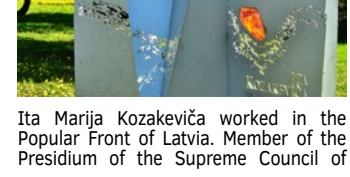
**19 House of the Skulme family**  
The family of Skulmes has given Latvia a number of great and well-known painters – Oto, Uga and Džemma Skulme. The house was built in 1895 by Jēkabs Skulme who worked in the Jēkabpils City Council in the 20th century and was the first to have courage to propose using the Latvian language at the council meetings. The house can be only viewed from the outside.

**20 House of the organist P. Spīnoliņš**  
Pēteris Spīnoliņš was a music teacher and one of the most famous organists in Latvia. His family home was built in 1820.

**21 "Little violinist" a sculpture in memory of composer Jāzeps Vītols**  
The author of the bronze sculpture is Aigars Bikše. It is approximately 80 cm high.

**22 Commemorative site for Eriks Rūdolfs Zilinskis**  
A memorial stone devoted to a citizen of Jēkabpils, the painter, Master of jurisprudence and founder of the Latvian Welfare Association "Daugavas Vanagi".

**23 Commemorative site for Ita Kozakeviča**  
Ita Marija Kozakeviča worked in the Popular Front of Latvia. Member of the Presidium of the Supreme Council of Latvia.

**24 The oldest wooden house in Jēkabpils**  
Former chancery of the Jēkabpils St. Michael's Lutheran Church congregation, built in 1808.

**25 Old Town Square**  
At the beginning of the 20th century, the current Old Town Square developed as the city's market square. Most of the buildings around it were built between 19th and 20th centuries. Now guests are greeted by the symbol of the city – lynx. Also various environmental objects are reminding of the former bustle of the market.

**26 Daugava embankment – promenade**  
The construction of the embankment was commenced in 1981 after the great floods. Now, walking along the pedestrian promenade, you can enjoy beautiful views of the city and the calm flow of the river Daugava.

**27 Bridge across Daugava**  
The first bridge with a railway line across the Daugava was built in 1936. It was destroyed during WWII. In 1962 the current bridge was built, uniting two cities Krustpils and Jēkabpils under one name – Jēkabpils.

**28 O. Kalpak's Square and fountain "Dandelion Fluff"**  
Former festivity parade square. In 1928 to honor Latvia's tenth anniversary it was renamed to Oskars Kalpaks Square. Improved with tourism infrastructure of Struve geodetic arc. Fountain located near the Jēkabpils State Gymnasium. Sculptures by the sculptor L. Blumbergs can be seen next to the fountain.

**29 The former district school**  
The former district school was built in 1820 in the Classicist style. It adds a majestic touch to the centre of the city with its massive columns. The building currently houses the Jēkabpils Technical School of Technology.

**30 19th century dwelling house ensemble**  
Witnesses of the old town planning – the so-called "string houses".

**31 19th century dwelling house**  
The author of the bronze sculpture is Aigars Bikše. It is approximately 80 cm high.

**32 Akmeņu Street Square**  
Corner of Pasta and Akmeņu streets is called also Nut Square due to the walnut trees that are growing there. After the reconstruction, a central environmental object was installed – a fountain with a stone sphere. Sculptures by the sculptor Vija Dzintare – "Austras tree" and "Gates" are installed in the square symbolizing the ideas of awakening period.

**33 The former Wednesday market square**  
On this spot on 12th February 1670, Duke Jacob declared the foundation of Jēkabpils city. It was the oldest market of the town and the former historic center.

**34 Kens manor and park**  
A former manor – the only 19th century neogothic building in Jēkabpils. Now the building houses the Jēkabpils Art School. There is also a children playground available and a secular tree of national importance in the park – a European larch.

**35 Forest Park**  
The park was planted in 1966 to protect the city from the dust created in the dolomite quarry. The Forest Park is located next to Radži water reservoir, which has a Blue Flag beach. An active recreation area is available on site.

**36 Environmental object – sculpture "Prosperity"**  
Its metal silhouette is filled with dolomite gravel, symbolizing Dolomita Street and the former dolomite quarry, where the Radži Reservoir is now located.

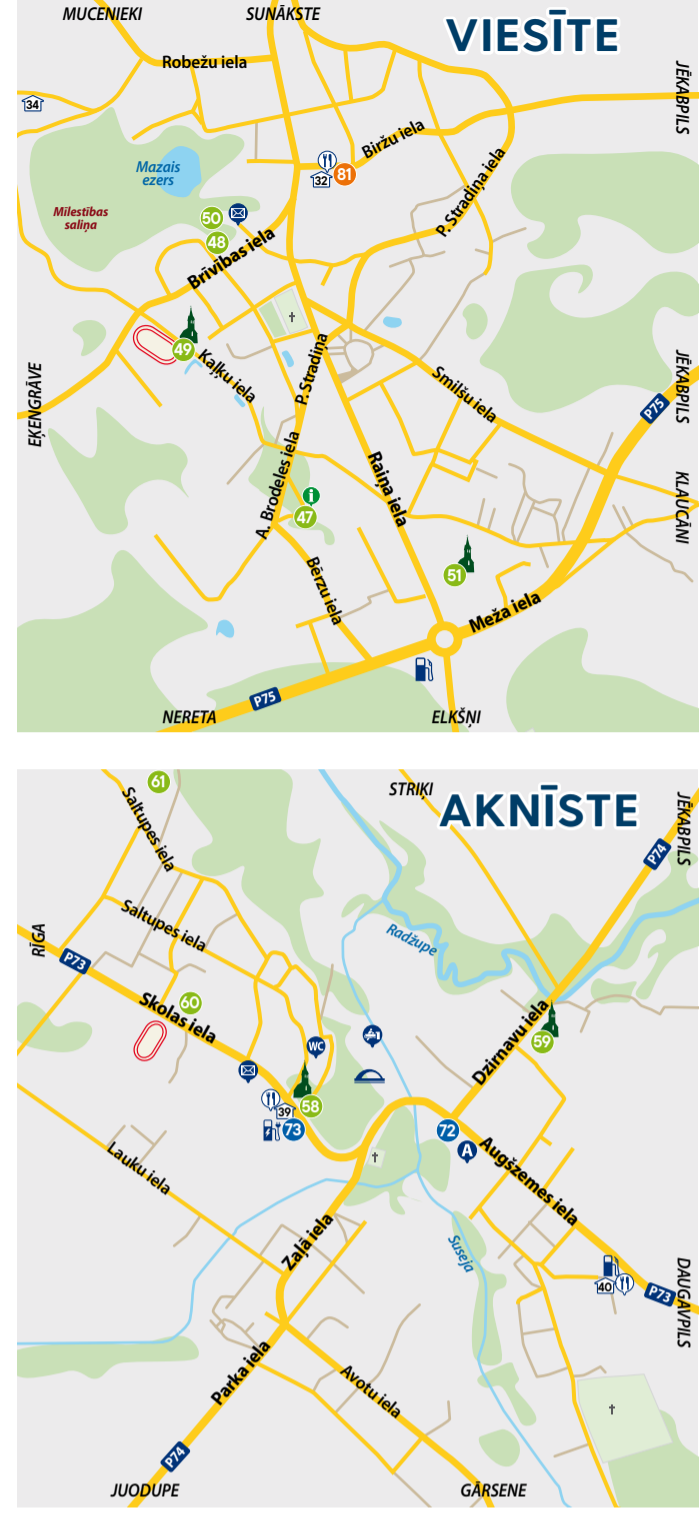
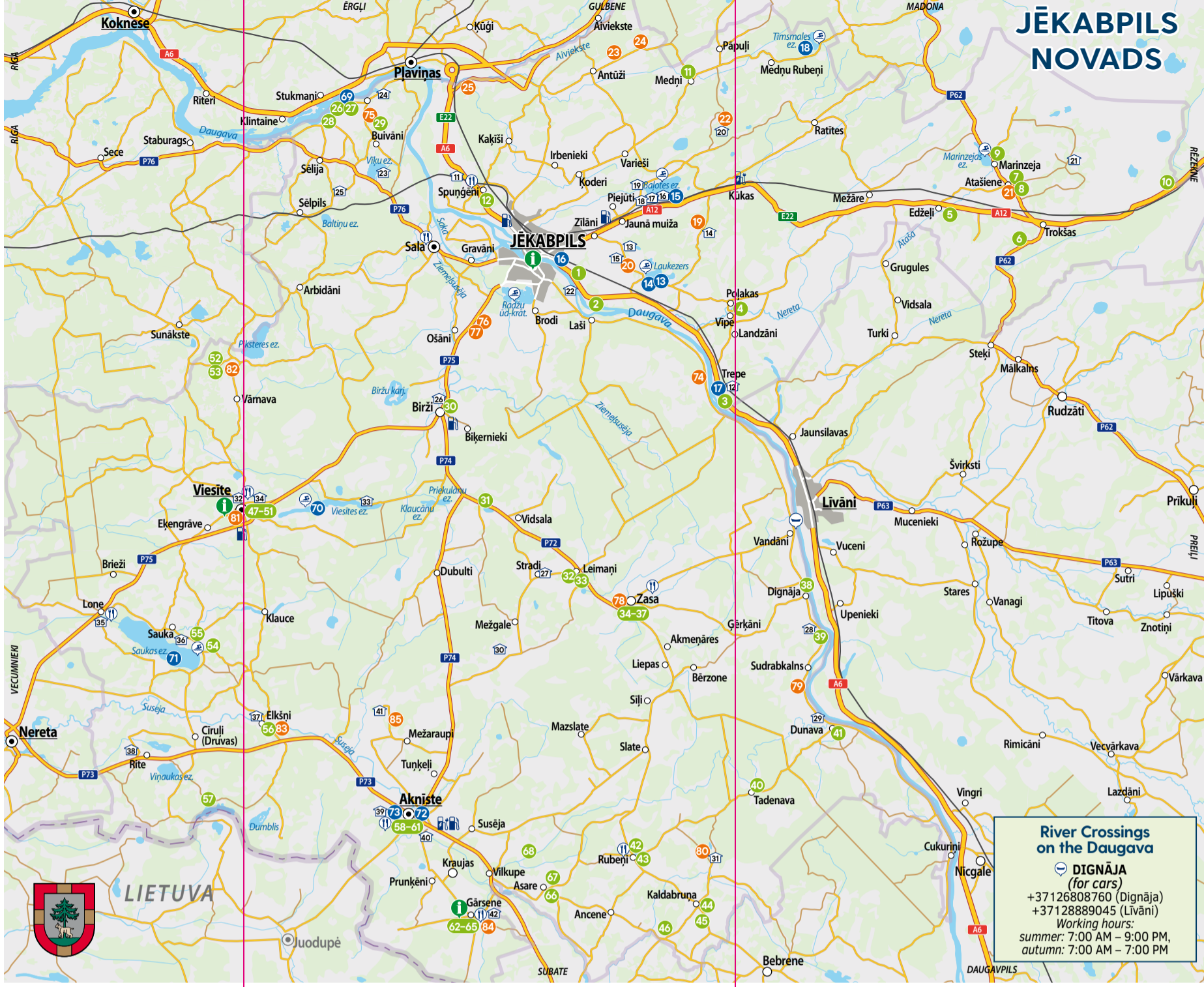


# RIGHT BANK OF THE RIVER DAUGAVA

- 1 Asote Castle Mound**  
Asote Castle Mound with its artificially steepened slopes was once the administrative and military centre of the Asote region inhabited by the ancient Latgalians. The castle mound was inhabited from the 1st millennium BC up to the 13th century AD.

- 2 Rogāji Grand Stone and Nature Trail**  
Visitors can glimpse into the workshop of ceramics artists Ineta Dzirkaile and discover the creative process behind various clay items, as well as try their hand at clay handling.

- 3 Vaiki Grand Stone**  
The stone here measures 7.5x5.7x2.6 m and resembles a flat table. Legend has it that the devil himself brought it here. And Russian Tsar Peter I, as well as Napoleon used to dine at the top of it.

- 4 Crafts Centre "Māzers"**  
The Marinceja Manor complex was established in the mid-19th century. The adjoining park of a mixed English and French style and the shore of Marinceja Lake is an excellent place for a stroll. There are dedicated rest, swimming areas and walking trails here.

- 5 Endžēļi Promori Old-Believers' House of Prayer**  
Built in the second half of the 19th century. It can be viewed only from the outside.

- 6 Ceramics Workshop "Zalbirzes"**  
Visitors can glimpse into the workshop of ceramics artists Ineta Dzirkaile and discover the creative process behind various clay items, as well as try their hand at clay handling.

- 7 Retro Motorcycle and Antiquity Collection**  
The collection consists of military uniforms, weapons and motorcycles from various countries used during various periods and for various purposes.

- 8 Atāšiene Our Lady of Sorrows Roman Catholic Church**  
The dual steep stone church was built between 1931 and 1938 and was consecrated in 1939. The main altar features an icon of Our Lady of Sorrows.

- 9 Marinceja Manor, Park and Lake**  
The Marinceja Manor complex was established in the mid-19th century. The adjoining park of a mixed English and French style and the shore of Marinceja Lake is an excellent place for a stroll. There are dedicated rest, swimming areas and walking trails here.

- 10 Kristakrūgs Observation Tower and Teiči Bōg**  
The 27 metre high observation tower provides an excellent view of the expanse of Teiči Nature Reserve – with an area of over 19 000 ha it is one of the largest raised bogs in the Baltic States. Visits to the reserve are allowed only when accompanied

- 11 Unguri (Medņi) Evangelical Lutheran Church**  
The church was constructed in 1828 on the Madonā-Trepe rampart. It was restored in 1892 and 1926. The steeple was destroyed by Soviet artillery during World War II. The congregation has been gradually restoring the church since 2004. Camping site is available.

- 12 Ceramics workshop "DR Keramikā"**  
This workshop is the creative space of artist Daiga. Available Master classes for groups.

- 26 Sēlpils Castle Mound and Medieval Castle Ruins**  
The 13th–18th century Teutonic Order castle was built on an ancient Selonian castle mound, which dates back to the late 9th millennium BC. From the 6th until the 12th century this was the political and military seat of the Selonian region. The castle mound is located on an island in the River Daugava.

- 27 Sēlpils Evangelical Lutheran Church**  
Constructed in 1846–1850. Destroyed during the World War II. The church is currently undergoing a rebirth. It is also called "the Green Church".

- 28 Krustalciņš Cliff**  
The longest cliff in Latvia. Spanning a length of over 2.5 km along the River Daugava. Once a canyon with a depth of up to 40 metres, today the cliffs form an inaccessible wall along the river at a height of 2 to 4 metres. The cliffs can be viewed by boat from the Daugava.

- 29 Taborkalns or Daborkalns Hill**  
The highest hillock in the northern Selonian Highland. Point of Struve Geodetic Arc "Dabors-kalns". A 28 metre high observation tower sits on top of the hillock.

The stone church was constructed in
- 31 Aleksandrs Grīns Park**  
The park is a home to open-air art objects based on the literary works of Aleksandrs Grīns and a monument to the writer.

- 46 Stender's Park and Gate of Light**  
The church was built in 1940. The interior decorations have been preserved from the original wooden church dating back to 1774, and the red-brick gates of the old church have also been preserved.

- 47 V. Ancītis Aknīste Library Local History Room**  
A collection of Aknīste historical artefacts is on display in the library. Also provides guided tours of Aknīste and its surrounding area.
